- Rajamalai National Park is closed from 15th January till 1st April every year, so in that period on the way to Munnar we will instead offer a complimentary visit to the Thattekad Bird Sanctuary which is also known as the Salim Ali bird sanctuary; alternatively, travellers can visit Top Station in Munnar on Day 4.
- Travellers are requested to carry documents at the time of checking out from each hotel.
