Day 1 - 6 : Los Angeles

Day 7 - 8 : San Luis Obispo

you'll find the stunning Hearst Castle. Once home to newspaper billionaire William Randolph Hearst, you can spend hours soaking up the splendour of this magnificent

building and its gardens.

Day 8 - 10 : San Francisco

sure not to miss the famous 17 mile drive where you'll see the manicured golf courses and multi-million dollar mansions of Pebble Beach. On arrival in San Francisco,

National Parks: Kings Canyon, Death Valley and Sequoia. Keep an eye out for Mount Whitney, the highest point in the contiguous United States, as well as the lowest,

Bad water Basin in Death Valley.

Desert. This relaxing 3 hour drive finishes in the town of

Barstow which was once saw The Old Spanish Trail and Route 66 pass this way.
